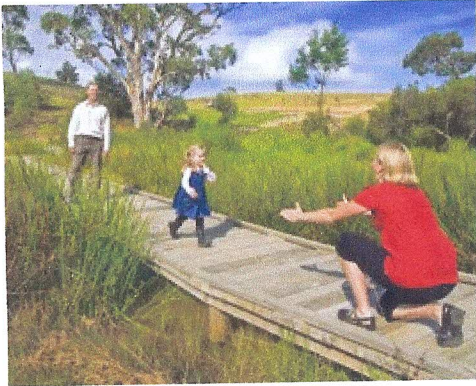

LANDSCAPING LEGEND LENDS A HAND
